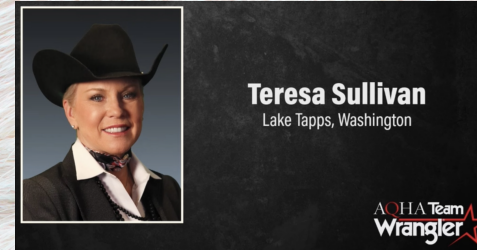
Roundtable Moderator
